If people were like trees they would have their feet planted firmly in the ground and carry their heads in the sky, in heaven.

The treehouse is connected to the trunk with two platforms. The lower platform is for sleeping and sanitary areas and the upper platform is for living and cooking.

The roof is a flexible, tentlike structure based on the classical wood constructions of East Asia and Oceania; it is built of eight wooden poles that are bound in pairs to form the lower platform. The poles form an enclosure at the lower level and extend over the upper level into the palm-leafed roof. Depending on the angle, the viewer sees the roof as a sail or as a crown. Let's be carried away by the palm-sail, or crowned by the palm roof!
